## Grand Canyon (Ariz.) Takes the Top Spot in Final 2012-13 Division II #LSDC

**CLEVELAND** – For the second year in a row, the Learfield Sports Directors' Cup has been claimed by **Grand Canyon (Ariz.)**; edging **Grand Valley State (Mich.)** by a close score of 954.75-939.25. This is the Lopes second straight Learfield Sports Directors' Cup title.

Grand Canyon will be honored at the 2013 NACDA Convention during the Learfield Sports Directors' Cup luncheon sponsored by United States Olympic Committee, on Friday, June 14.

Grand Canyon scored in the maximum 14 sports, including third place in women's indoor track & field; fourth in men's swimming and men's outdoor track & field; fifth in baseball and women's golf; sixth in women's outdoor track & field; ninth in men's soccer and wrestling; 10<sup>th</sup> in men's indoor track & field and men's golf; 11<sup>th</sup> in women's swimming; and 17<sup>th</sup> in women's volleyball, women's basketball and women's tennis. The Lopes had two scores omitted due to the seven maximum allowed for women's and men's sports - softball and men's basketball.

**Grand Valley State (Mich.)** finished in second, after scoring in 13 sports. The Lakers won the women's cross country national championship; third in women's soccer, baseball, softball and women's outdoor track & field; fourth in women's and men's indoor track & field; seventh in men's cross country; 11<sup>th</sup> in men's swimming; 13<sup>th</sup> in women's golf; 14<sup>th</sup> in women's swimming; 23<sup>rd</sup> in men's golf and 27<sup>th</sup> in men's outdoor track & field. Grand Valley State points also had two scores omitted in women's tennis and women's volleyball as they reached the seven maximum sports allowed for women's sports.

**Ashland (Ohio)** finished in third with 912.50 points. The Eagles scored in 14 sports and claimed the women's basketball national championship.

In fourth place with 763.25 total points is **Minnesota State Mankato**. The Mavericks scored in 12 sports with their highest finish coming in baseball (second place).

**Adams State (Co.)** rounds out the top five with 625.50 total points. The Grizzlies scored in nine sports and claimed the men's cross country national championship.

The **Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference** placed two institutions in the top five, Grand Valley State (2<sup>nd</sup>) and Ashland (3<sup>rd</sup>). The **Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference** and the **Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference** placed two institutions in the top ten, Minnesota State Mankato (4<sup>th</sup>) and Augustana (SD) (6<sup>th</sup>); and Adams State (CO) (5<sup>th</sup>) and Colorado School of Mines (10<sup>th</sup>).

The following institutions capturing spring national titles: men's outdoor track & field – Saint Augustine's (NC); women's outdoor track & field – Academy of Art (CA); baseball – Tampa (FL); women's rowing – Nova Southeastern (FL); men's lacrosse – Le Moyne (NY); men's golf – Barry (FL); softball – Central Oklahoma.

The Learfield Sports Directors' Cup was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and USA Today. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in up to 14 sports -- seven women's and seven men's.
